CODE OF CONDUCT AND ETHICS

It is this Union's objective to ensure that all players and officials representing the Southern Cape Golf Union be identified through their exemplary behaviour, both on and off the course.

This will be achieved as much through attitude and behaviour towards fellow competitors, opponents, team mates and officials, as through the standard of play.

Players are expected to comport themselves at all times in a manner which will reflect favourably on both themselves and on the Southern Cape Golf Union and to protect and honour the Union's colours.

The principles as laid down by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the South African Golf Association are to adhere to at all times with special regard to:

- The Rules
- Equity and Conduct
- Standard of Fair Play
- Sportsmanlike Conduct
- Golf Etiquette

Players and Officials, when travelling on public transport to and from tournaments while representing the Union shall wear full step out colours, ie blazer, tie, etc

Examples of inappropriate / unacceptable behaviour inviting disciplinary action would include, but are not limited to the action specified in the attached addendum, such as:

- Defacing or damaging of kit or clothing
- Rough play, throwing of clubs, damaging the course, etc
- Rowdiness, excessive drinking, etc
- Abusive and foul language, etc
