



CLARIFICATION OF FREQUENTY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR THE REGIONAL SANLAM CANSA FINALS 2014

1. <u>HANDICAP DIVISIONS</u>

2. Conditions applicable to all Competitions (page 1)

2. Conditions applicable to all Competitions.

2.1. Competitions will be decided by Stableford Stroke Play in accordance with the Rules of golf as approved by the R&A Ltd and in accordance with the Local Rules approved by the Tournament Committee;

2.2. Each competition will be divided up into Handicap Divisions as follows:

2.2.1. Men:

2.2.1.1. A Division: Handicap 0 to 9;

2.2.1.2. B Division: Handicap 10 to 18;

2.2.1.3. C Division: Handicap 19 to maximum 30*.

If a player has a handicap of greater than 30 he may compete in a Club Competition provided he plays off a handicap no greater than 30.

2.2.2. Women:

2.2.2.1. A Division: Handicap 0 to 16;

2.2.2.2. B Division: Handicap 17 to 24;

2.2.2.3. C Division: Handicap 25 to 36.

2. WHAT IF MY HANDICAP HAS CHANGED SINCE WINNING AT MY HOME CLUB?

4. Conditions applicable to the Regional Final Competitions (Page 3)

4.7. A player shall play in the Handicap Division, in which he or she participated in during his or her Club Competition, from their current official handicap, irrespective of whether or not this falls within the handicap range of the Handicap Division he or she competed in during the Club Competition (eg. In the Men's Competition, if a player plays in the Club Competition with an official handicap of 19 and wins the C Division, improves his handicap, to say 13, by the time the Regional Final Competition takes place, then he must play in the C Division (in the Regional Final Competition) off his current official handicap of 13.).

For a player playing in the Men's Competition, whose handicap is greater than 30, then 2.2.1.3. applies as to the maximum handicap permissible in the Regional Final Competition.

3. <u>WINNER/TIES</u>

3. Conditions applicable to Club Competitions (Page 2)

3.8. Prizes:

3.8.1. The player, in each Handicap Division (see 2.2. above), recording the highest total number of Stableford points will be the winner;

3.8.2. In the event of a tie in any prize winning position, the winner will be determined as follows:

3.8.2.1. There will be a count out over holes 10 to 18, in the sequence listed below, until a winner is determined:

3.8.2.1.1. The player recording the highest total number of points on holes 10 to 18;

3.8.2.1.2. The player recording the highest total number of points on holes 13 to 18;

3.8.2.1.3. The player recording the highest total number of points on holes 16 to 18;

3.8.2.1.4. The player recording the most Stableford Points on hole 18;

3.8.2.2. If the procedure in 3.8.2.1. fails to determine a winner, then the player with the lowest official handicap amongst those still tying after

application of paragraph 3.8.2.1.4. will be declared the winner. If this fails to determine a winner, then; 3.8.2.3. The Tournament Committee shall determine the winner, their decision being final.

4. <u>GOLF CARTS</u>

Golf Carts are not encouraged as no golf carts are allowed in the Finals when playing the Gary Player Course at Sun City. **Regional Finals Golf Carts ONLY WITH MEDICAL CERTIFICATE.**
