INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Conditions of Play

The competition will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and Local Rules as approved by the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Entry Requirements

Open to Amateurs who are older than **50 (Fifty)** years of age, and members of a Golf Club affiliated to the Southern Cape Golf Union and who have a handicap index of **24 (Twenty-Four)** or less as assessed in terms of the SAGA Course Rating and Handicapping System. **Players must be 50 (fifty) years of age on the start date of the tournament.**

Entries

Entries will be limited to 104. Should more than 104 entries be received, entries will be reduced by ballot in terms of higher handicap index. The maximum Handicap Index that may enter is set at 24.0.

Form of Competition

The tournament is played over one day. 18 Holes will be played on Saturday morning 26th January 2019 at Kingswood Golf Estate. All players will enter using their Handicap index, and our Scoring Program will then calculate your Course Handicap on the morning of play. The Divisions will be as follow:

- **A Division (0 – 9 Course Handicap) will play Medal & Individual Stableford,**
- **B Division (10 + Course Handicap) will play Individual Stableford.**

In the event of a tie for the championship, the “Title” will be shared. All other count outs will be done using the R&A Tournament count out method. This will be done via the Albatros Scoring Program that will be used during the 2018 OOM season. SCGU will also be sending an official scorer to this Senior Open.

Entry Procedure

Please enter online via or website www.scgu.co.za. Alternatively, entry forms are obtainable from Kingswood Golf Estate, Secretaries of Affiliated Golf Clubs, and the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Closing date

Entries close at noon on Wednesday 23rd January 2019. **Late entries and entries without payment or payment arrangement will not be accepted.**

Withdrawals

Only written or faxed cancellation will be accepted and if received after the closing date no refund will be made.

Draw & Starting Times

The draw will be conducted by the Southern Cape Golf Union. Tee times will start from 07h30, and players will be seeded according to handicap. Two tee start will be used, and players will play in 4 balls. Any competitor who is absent from the tee when called upon to start will be liable to disqualification or penalty under Rule 5.3a. The draw will be available at Kingswood Golf Estate, the Southern Cape Golf Union's office and on the Unions web site www.scgu.co.za by Thursday 24th January 2019. It is the player's responsibility to obtain his tee-off time.

Registration

All participating players must register at least 30 minutes prior to their tee off time on Saturday 26th January 2019.

The registration area will be located on the middle floor of the Club House.

***Breach of this condition will result in disqualification.**

Practise

All competing players will be allowed to use the Kingswood driving range & warm up area prior to their round. Range balls will be provided at R20 per bucket. The practise area is located opposite the parking area of the Kingswood Club House. The practise putting green is located next to the 18th green, and the chipping green is located next to the 1st Green and 10th Tee.

Decisions

Decisions and disputes of any kind will be dealt with by the Tournament Committee of the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Golf Carts

PLEASE NOTE that it will be compulsory for all competing players to ride on a golf cart. Cart fees are included in your entry fee, and this ensures that the playing field is fair. Players without an RSA driver's license will be drawn with a valid driver's license holder. **All competing players must sign Kingswood Golf Estate's golf cart Indemnity Form. Further note that all Golf Carts are equipped with a Satellite GPS.**

Dress Code

- Soft spikes.
- Golf specific shorts will be allowed. Shorts must be knee length and cargo or draw string shorts are not permitted.
- Only recognised golf attire will be allowed. No collarless shirts.

Distance Measuring Devices (D.M.D's)

For the duration of the tournament a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4.3a(1).

***Penalty for breach of Rule 4.3a(1):** First offence: Two Strokes, Second offence: Disqualification

Prize Giving

The Southern Cape Golf Union hereby requests that all competing players please attend the prize giving on Saturday 26th January 2019. Failure to attend will lead to players forfeiting their prize. Your respect towards the above request will be much appreciated.

General

A request is made to all players to please respect the courtesy granted by the Kingswood Golf Estate by undertaking to repair all divots and pitch marks, and not to litter the golf course and surrounds. Sand holders will be supplied on each cart. Also, please adhere to the pace of play regulations.

Exemption of Liability

The Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA & GolfRSA and their management will not be held responsible for any damages, loss, including;

Personal loss and or other forms of loss, harm or injury sustained as stipulated below:

- a) Physical and/or emotional injuries suffered during the tournament/championship, due to any acts of God, suffered as a direct result thereof, including aspects such as being struck by lightning, etc.
- b) Physical injuries of any kind suffered by any person, including a player or spectator sustained by own negligence, or otherwise.
- c) Emotional injuries sustained due to any loss, including death, suffered because of any of the above injuries sustained personally or by a spectator.
- d) Damages suffered to any property of a player.
- e) The player acknowledges the exemption of liability of the Union and its management as listed above when he signs the acknowledgement or agrees to the Conditions of Entry. He also acknowledges the contents of the above, he understands it, and exempts the Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA & GolfRSA from any liability as indicated above.
