INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Conditions of Play

The competition will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and Local Rules as approved by the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Entry Requirements

Open to Amateurs who are older than **30 (Thirty)** years of age, and who are members of a Golf Club affiliated to the South African Golf Association and who have a handicap index of **9.9** or less as assessed in terms of the GolfRSA / SAGA Course Rating and Handicapping System or other system acceptable to GolfRSA / SAGA. Players must be 30 (thirty) years of age before the start date of the tournament.

Entries

Entries will be limited to **90 players**. Should more than 90 entries be received, entries will be reduced by the Tournament Organizing Committee based on the SAGA Mid-Amateur Rankings, higher handicaps or by means they deem to be fair.

Exemption Categories:

Entrants who are exempt from a ballot will be:

- a) The top 50 players on the SAGA Mid-Amateur Player Ranking list as of Monday, 3rd June 2019,
- b) The top 10 players on the SCGU Mid-Amateur OOM Ranking list as of Monday, 3rd June 2019,
- c) Other entrants as determined by the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Form of Competition

The tournament is played over two days using both the Montagu & Outeniqua Course at Fancourt Golf Estate. Eighteen (18) holes Medal Stroke Play will be played on Saturday afternoon 15th June 2019 at the Montagu Course. Eighteen (18) holes Medal Stroke Play will be played on Sunday morning 16th June 2019 at the Outeniqua Course. In the event of a tie for the championship, a sudden death play-off will take place until the winner is determined.

Entry Procedure

Closing date

Entries close at 12h00 on Monday 3rd June 2019. **Late entries, entries without payment and entries not on the prescribed form will not be accepted.**

Withdrawals

Only written or faxed cancellation will be accepted and if received after the closing date no refund will be made.

Draw & Starting Times

The draw will be conducted by the Southern Cape Golf Union. Tee times will start from 11h00-13h00 on Saturday 15th June, and from 08h00-12h00 on Sunday 16th June 2019. Two tee starts will be used at the Montagu Course on Saturday 15th June, and a one tee start will be used at the Outeniqua Course on Sunday 16th June (*as per instructions from Fancourt*). Players will be seeded according to handicap index and play in 3 balls. Any competitor who is absent from the tee when called upon to start will be liable to disqualification or penalty under Rule 5.3a. The draw will be available on Monday 3rd June 2019 at Fancourt Golf Estate, GolfRSA www.golfrsa.co.za, Southern Cape Golf Union's office and on the Unions web site www.scqu.co.za. It is the player's responsibility to obtain his tee-off time.

Registration

All participating players must register at least 30 minutes prior to their tee off time on Saturday 15th June 2019 only. The registration area will be located in the lounge area of the Club Lounge.

***Breach of this condition will result in disqualification.**

Decisions

Decisions and disputes of any kind will be dealt with by the Tournament Committee of the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Practice Area

All competing players will be allowed to use the driving range, putting and chipping green that is located in close proximity to the Clubhouse. Range balls will be for your own account.

Meals

All competing players will receive Lunch after 18 holes on Sunday 16th June 2019. This is included in your entry fee.

Golf Carts

Golf Carts are not allowed to be used by competing Players. No Players bag is allowed on a Golf Cart.

Caddies

This will be the Players responsibility. All Players must arrange for caddies with Fancourt Golf Estate on +27 (0)44 804 0000. PLEASE NOTE that no outside caddies will be allowed, because of the estates security policy.

Dress Code

- a) Soft spikes.
- b) Golf specific shorts will be allowed. Shorts must be knee length and cargo or draw string shorts are not permitted.
- c) Only recognised golf attire will be allowed. No collarless shirts.

Distance Measuring Devices (D.M.D's)

For the duration of the tournament a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4-3a(1).

***Penalty for breach of Rule 4-3a(1):** First offence: Two Strokes, Second offence: Disqualification

Prize Giving

The Southern Cape Golf Union hereby requests that all competing players please attend the prize giving on Sunday 16th June 2019. Failure to attend will lead to players forfeiting their prize. Your respect towards the above request will be much appreciated.

General

A request is made to all players to please respect the courtesy granted by Fancourt Golf Estate by undertaking to repair all divots and pitch marks, and not to litter the golf course and surrounds.

Exemption of Liability

The Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA & GolfRSA and their management will not be held responsible for any damages, loss, including;

Personal loss and or other forms of loss, harm or injury sustained as stipulated below:

- a) Physical and/or emotional injuries suffered during the tournament/championship, due to any acts of God, suffered as a direct result thereof, including aspects such as being struck by lightning, etc.
- b) Physical injuries of any kind suffered by any person, including a player or spectator sustained by own negligence, or otherwise.
- c) Emotional injuries sustained due to any loss, including death, suffered because of any of the above injuries sustained personally or by a spectator.
- d) Damages suffered to any property of a player.
- e) The player acknowledges the exemption of liability of the Union and its management as listed above when he signs the acknowledgement or agrees to the Conditions of Entry. He also acknowledges the contents of the above, he understands it, and exempts the Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA & GolfRSA from any liability as indicated above.
