INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Conditions of Play

The competition will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and Local Rules as approved by the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Entry Requirements

Open to Amateurs who are members of a Golf Club affiliated to the South African Golf Association (SAGA), Womens Golf South Africa (WGSA), or a governing body recognized by SAGA / WGSA, and who have a handicap Index of **36 (Thirty-six)** or less as assessed in terms of the SAGA / WGSA Course Rating and Handicapping System.

Entries

Entries will be limited to 88 players (44 pairings). Should more than 88 entries (44 pairings) be received, entries will be reduced by ballot in terms of higher handicap index.

Form of Competition

The tournament is played over one day. Thirty-six (36) Holes will be played on Sunday 24th February 2019 at Oubaai Golf Club, and the Format and Divisions will be as follow:

- **AM** - 18 Holes Better Ball Medal - Score Gross and Nett on every Hole!
- **PM** - 18 Holes Foursomes Medal – Course Handicaps must be added together and divided by 2, then rounded up. Record gross scores and deduct pairings course handicap at the end!
- A Division (combined course handicap of 9 and under)
- B Division (combined course handicap of 10 - 18)
- C Division (combined course handicap of 19 - 36)

In the event of a tie for the championship, a sudden death play-off will take place over Holes 16, 17 & 18 until the winner is determined.

PLEASE NOTE that all handicaps will be HNA verified on Thursday 21st February 2019. These verified handicaps will be used for the “AM” Better Ball Medal. SCGU will then add each pairings course handicap together, divide by two and then round up for the “PM” Foursomes as per our scoring system requirements. These handicaps of all pairings will apply on Sunday 24th February, irrespective of any changes that may occur between Thursday 21st February and Sunday 24th February. Both Nett and Gross prizes will be awarded in all three (3) Divisions.

Tee Markers

All the competing Ladies Golfers will play from the Oubaai Red Tees, and all the competing Men's Golfers will play from the Oubaai White Tees. No other Tee Markers are in play for this Championship.

Entry Procedure

Please enter completing the above entry form – no online entry option available because of two players entering. Alternatively, entry forms are obtainable from Oubaai Golf Club, Secretaries of Affiliated Golf Clubs, and the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Closing date

Entries close at 12h00 on Wednesday 20th February 2019. **Late entries and entries without payment or payment arrangement will not be accepted.**

Withdrawals

Only written cancellation will be accepted and if received after the closing date no refund will be made.

Draw & Starting Times

The draw will be conducted by the Southern Cape Golf Union. “AM” shotgun to start at 08h00, and “PM” shotgun to start at 13h00. Please allow enough time to get to your respective starting hole. Any competitor who is absent from the tee when called upon to start will be liable to disqualification or penalty under Rule 5.3a. The draw will be available at Oubaai Golf Club, the Southern Cape Golf Union's office and on the Unions web site www.scgu.co.za on Thursday 21st February 2019. It is the player's responsibility to obtain his tee-off time.

Registration

All participating players must register at least 30 minutes prior to their tee off time on Sunday 24th February 2019. The registration area will be located in the Lounge Area of the Club House at Oubaai Golf Club.

***Breach of this condition will result in disqualification.**

Decisions

Decisions and disputes of any kind will be dealt with by the Tournament Committee of the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Practise

All competing players will be allowed to use the Oubaai driving range & warm up area prior to their round. Range balls will be provided free of charge. The driving range is located opposite the parking area of the Oubaai Hotel. The practise putting & chipping greens located next to the 1st Tee.

Golf Carts

PLEASE NOTE that it will be compulsory for all competing players to ride on a golf cart. Cart fees are included in your entry fee, and this ensures that the playing field is fair. Players without a RSA driver's license will be drawn with a valid driver's license holder. All competing players must sign Oubaai Golf Club's golf cart Indemnity Form.

Meals

All competing players will receive Lunch after 18 Holes on Sunday 24th February 2019. This is included in your entry fee.

Dress Code

- a) Soft spikes.
- b) Golf specific and recognised golf attire will be allowed.

Distance Measuring Devices (D.M.D's)

For the duration of the tournament a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4.3a(1).

***Penalty for breach of Rule 4.3a(1):** First offence: Two Strokes, Second offence: Disqualification

Prize Giving

The Southern Cape Golf Union hereby requests that all competing players please attend the prize giving on Sunday 24th February 2019. Failure to attend will lead to players forfeiting their prize. Your respect towards the above request will be much appreciated.

General

A request is made to all players to please respect the courtesy granted by Oubai Golf Club by undertaking to repair all divots and pitch marks, and not to litter the golf course and surrounds.

Exemption of Liability

The Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA, WGSA & GolfRSA and their management will not be held responsible for any damages, loss, including;

Personal loss and or other forms of loss, harm or injury sustained as stipulated below:

- a) Physical and/or emotional injuries suffered during the tournament/championship, due to any acts of God, suffered as a direct result thereof, including aspects such as being struck by lightning, etc.
- b) Physical injuries of any kind suffered by any person, including a player or spectator sustained by own negligence, or otherwise.
- c) Emotional injuries sustained due to any loss, including death, suffered because of any of the above injuries sustained personally or by a spectator.
- d) Damages suffered to any property of a player.
- e) The player acknowledges the exemption of liability of the Union and its management as listed above when he signs the acknowledgement or agrees to the Conditions of Entry. He also acknowledges the contents of the above, he understands it, and exempts the Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA, WGSA & GolfRSA from any liability as indicated above.
