CODE OF CONDUCT AND ETHICS

It is this Union's objective to ensure that all players and officials representing the Southern Cape Golf Union will be identified through their exemplary behaviour, both on and off the course. This will be achieved by their attitude and behaviour towards fellow competitors, opponents, team mates and officials, as well as their standard of play.

Players are expected to conduct themselves at all times in a manner which will reflect favourably on both themselves and on the Southern Cape Golf Union and to protect and honour the Union's colours.

The principles as laid down by the R&A and GolfRSA are always to be adhered to with special regard to:

- The Rules
- Equity and conduct
- Standard of Fair Play
- Sportsmanlike Conduct
- Golf Etiquette

Players and Officials, when travelling on public transport to and from tournaments while representing the Union shall wear full step out colours, i.e. blazer, white shirt, tie (for males), black step out shoes, etc.

Examples of inappropriate/unacceptable behaviour inviting disciplinary action would include, but are not limited to the actions specified below, such as:

- Defacing or damaging of kit, clothing or property
- Rough play, throwing of clubs, damaging the course, etc.
- Rowdiness, excessive drinking, etc.
- Abusive and foul language, etc.
- The use of any banned substances.
