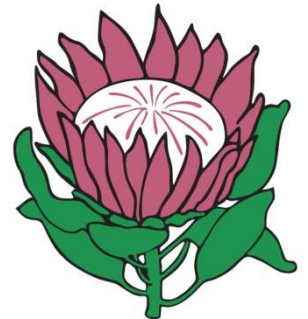

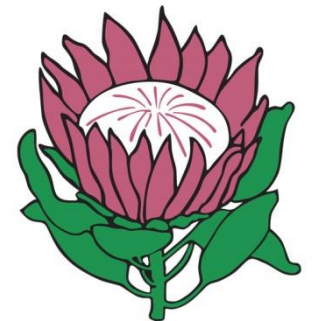
Feedback from the 2017 Southern Cape

FEEDBACK FROM / COMMENTS ON SUPER LEAGUE

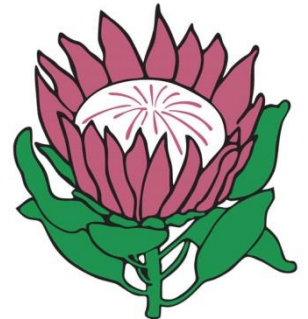
- Foursomes will not be played and will still be played in the format of singles only.
- Seeding of players will remain for the forthcoming season ensuring similar ability and thus competitiveness in terms of seeding matches is maintained.
- Order of Merit points for playing league will be continued with.
- SCGU foresaw some Senior & Junior players not being able to participate and hence Senior & Junior Invitational teams were entered separately. We would like to thank the clubs for including them as far as possible. The Junior team was evidence of that by getting promoted at the end of the 2016 season.

FEEDBACK FROM / COMMENTS ON SUPER LEAGUE

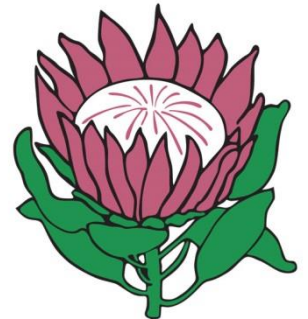
- The Seniors have suggested that they believe there are enough senior players for their own “Senior Super League” to be played (now that they have been promoted by winning the B division in 2017).
- Our initial concern was that of the number of participants at the clubs, however we are considering a separate Senior Super League consisting of “4-man” teams to be played at the same venue and same day as the “Mens” Super League.
- The reality is that there appears to be renewed interest at the Senior level and more Seniors are competing on the Senior Order Merit.

FEEDBACK FROM / COMMENTS ON SUPER LEAGUE

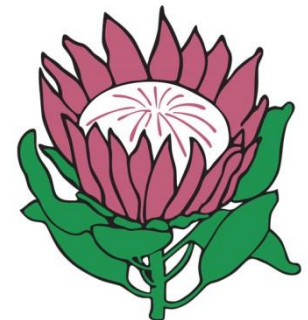
- Dependent on the number of entries the split with regard to the number of teams remaining in the A-division or staying in the B-division will be determined so as to ensure that we have enough teams in each division.
- The aforementioned is inclusive of the decision of the proposed Senior Super League.
- We felt that there is no need for a “Junior” League. The Juniors already participate in the Super League and also have a High Schools and Primary Schools League.

FEEDBACK FROM THE HANDICAPS LEAGUE

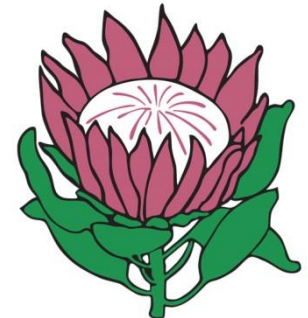
- A request not to play during school holidays was made.
 - As far as possible this will be avoided, but it is dependent on the club venue availability.
- We have met the 9-hole courses' request that they want to play on 18 hole courses against the other 9-hole clubs.
 - Reminder: The format of the Handicaps League ensures that 2 teams from the 9-hole courses make the Quarter Finals and this ensures an inclusive approach.
 - Due to the geographical location of the 9-hole clubs these games will be played in the George and Mossel Bay surrounds as far as possible. This will reduce travel logistics.

FEEDBACK FROM THE HANDICAPS LEAGUE

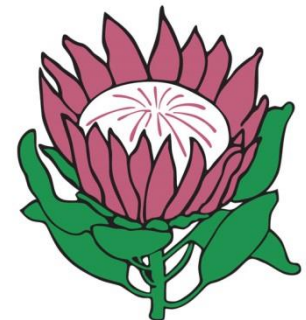
- The Captain's ability to seed players was requested.
 - This was done and will remain as provided for in the last season.
 - Captains will enter their teams via the entry form whereby players in foursomes matches 4 & 3 will have to play in singles matches 8, 7, 6 and 5. Therefore it follows that players in foursomes matches 2 & 1 will have to play in singles matches 4, 3, 2 and 1.
 - The aforementioned will apply at courses where a shotgun start is not adhered to. The reason for the aforementioned is to avoid delays in starting times in the afternoon singles matches.
 - At courses with a morning and afternoon shotgun start it is conceivable that this doesn't have to apply.
 - SCGU will send reminder emails of what structure is applicable at a particular fixture.

FEEDBACK FROM THE HANDICAPS LEAGUE

- Despite the successful Super League a number of players with a handicap of 3 or 4 felt that they were excluded from the Handicaps League and a request for the applicable eligible handicap to be reduced to 3 was received.
 - The aforementioned will remain the same.
- Seniors wanted to play Handicaps and Super League.
 - The concern with the aforementioned is:
 - There will be clashes.
 - The League Rules state: “Once a player, who has already played in the Jaguar / Land Rover Handicaps League, and thereafter plays in the Super League, the player will not be allowed to play in the Jaguar / Land Rover Handicaps League again during that League season.
- Shotgun starts resulted in finishing at a similar time and resulted in a more social environment. This will continue where possible.

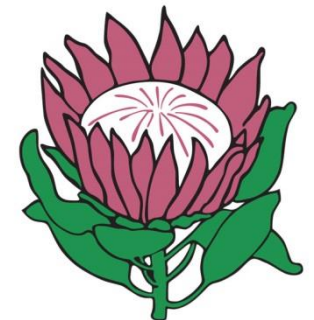

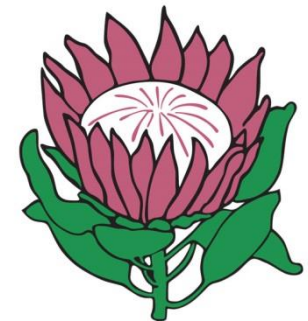

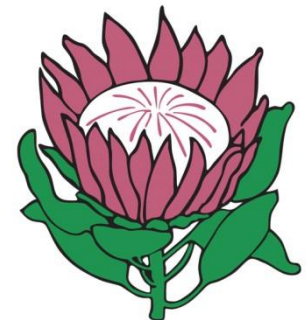

ENTRY FEES AND MATCH FEES 2018

- The Entry fee per Handicaps or Super League team is R1 650.
- In recognition of the difference between the Handicaps League and Super League, 36 holes versus 18 holes, the following fees are payable per player and by the players at a League fixture:

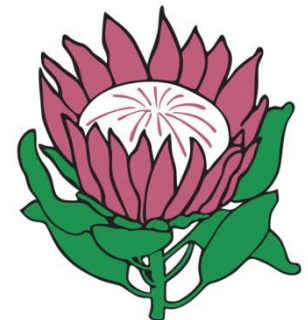

ENTRY PROCEDURES

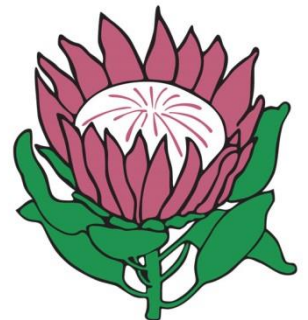

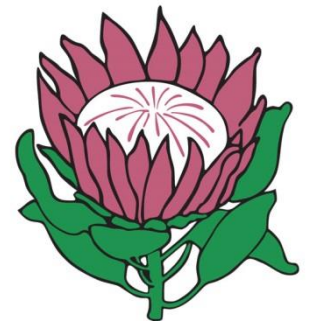

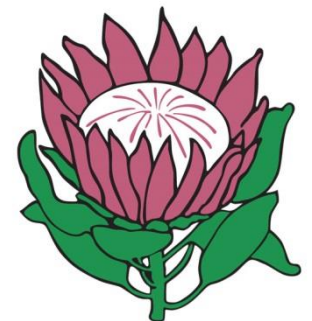
